



WELCOME BACK!

The staff at Bainbridge Nursing and Rehabilitation Center wants to welcome you back to our facility and we are very excited that you are finally able to see your loved ones in person. Although we know that you are eager to see your loved ones and they are eager to see you, our facility must follow guidance from the New York State Department of Health.

Based on the needs of the residents and facility structure, visitation can be conducted through a variety of means, in person, window visits, zoom calls, however, there are certain core principles and best practices that reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission and **MUST BE FOLLOWED**.

1. All visits are scheduled in advance with the Social Workers.
2. A maximum of 2 visitors are allowed per resident visit for 15 minutes.
3. The designated area for visitation is located in the Main Floor Conference Room.
4. Eating will not be allowed during the 15-minute visit.
5. Visitors under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
6. All visitors must present a COVID-19 negative test result within 72 hours or (3) days within the scheduled visit and they perform a self-test with the Abbott Rapid (must have negative result) on the day of the visit prior to allowing entrance to the facility.
7. All visitors must adhere to the written screening protocol and a valid ID must be presented to validate the visitor's identity.
8. The visitor's temperature will be checked prior to entering the building. Any visitor exhibiting fever (T100) and/or COVID-19 symptoms will not be allowed to visit.
9. A facemask **MUST** be worn at all times, no exception, alcohol-based hand sanitizer must be used to prevent the spread of germs and must adhere to social distancing (at least 6 feet apart from each other). There will be no physical contact allowed (i.e., kissing, hugging, and touching the resident).
10. The visitation area will be sanitized prior to and at the end of each visit.
11. The visitation schedule is from 1:00 pm through 4:00 pm daily at the main floor conference room. Each floor has a schedule to adhere to:
Monday-6th floor, Tuesday-5th floor, Wednesday-3rd floor, Thursday-4th floor and Friday-2nd floor.



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12. There has to be no new onset of COVID-19 cases in the last 14 days. If any resident or employee or both test positive for the COVID-19 19, all in person visitation will be suspended for 14 days.
13. COVID-19 positive residents, residents with COVID-19 signs or symptoms, and resident in a 14-day quarantine or observation period remain ineligible for in-person visits. Efforts will be made to accommodate visits using electronic devices.
14. Families that are allowed to visit their love ones in the room must wear full PPE-face mask, gloves, face shield, gown and must sanitize hands. Maintain social distancing(of 6 feet) at all times.

Please remember that you must adhere to the scheduled visitation time.

Please cooperate with us and abide by the visitation requirements so that you can continue to have visitation with your love one.

Failure to comply with the visitation requirements will result to temporary visitation restrictions.

Thank you for your anticipated compliance and enjoy your visit with your love ones.
